

Kiln Hire

You can hire any of our glass kilns for fusing, slumping and casting. We have 2 x Laser L6F kilns, 1 x Nabertherm GF240, 1 x Hobbyfuser Kiln, an L&L kiln and a Cromatie upright kiln. We can also hire worktop space to make your glass work to load into the kiln.

Laser L6F Glass Kiln – **Two** Available – Ideal for Fusing & Slumping

Size: 1000mm x 750mm x 250mm (internal)

Nabertherm GF240 Glass Kiln – **One** Available - Ideal for Fusing & Slumping and Casting

Kilncare Hobby Fuser – **One** Available - Ideal for Fusing & Slumping

Kiln Hire Terms and Conditions

The Glass Hub will provide equipment for hire as agreed with the hirer, as outlined above. We will enter kiln firing schedules as provided by the hirer, but do not provide support with firing schedules, this is the responsibility of the hirer. We do not provide technical support. In the event of any damage to kiln or kiln furniture caused by the hirer's use, the hirer will be held responsible and will be charged for the repair or replacement of any damage. In the event of an incorrect programme being entered by the hirer no responsibility will be held by The Glass Hub, and a firing that has been mis-programmed in such a way that it causes more power to be used than is normally expected by a standard firing, the excess usage in kilowatts will be charged for pro rata. Loading and unloading of kilns must be undertaken by the hirer. It is assumed that the hirer has sufficient understanding of the processes and operation of such equipment in order to be able to hire from us. The Glass Hub will not be held responsible for any unsuccessful firings of hirer's work, howsoever caused.

For a fee trained staff are available to help and advise the hirer regarding the firing processes. The Glass Hub, however, takes no responsibility for the outcomes of any technical information provided, as the responsibility for glass firings still lies with the hirer. The Glass Hub accepts no liability for any consequential loss as a result of hiring equipment. Fees for hire will still be payable even if the firing is unsuccessful.
